# Communal Reading: Acts 2: 4-17

One: All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked,

All: "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language?

One: Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs-

All: in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power."

One: All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another,

All: "What does this mean?"

One: But others sneered and said,

All: "They are filled with new wine."

One: But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, "(People) of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. The Celebration of Pentecost May 19, 2024 at 10:30 a.m.

The tribes of Wrestles with Creator (Israel) celebrated another great feast called the Festival of Weeks or Pentecost, meaning "fifty," because it was celebrated seven weeks after the Passover festival, on the fiftieth day. This was a harvest festival when the people would bring the firstfruits of the harvest to Creator's lodge in the Sacred Village of Peace (Jerusalem) and give thanks for his provision. Creator was about to send the Holy Spirit, promised by Creator Sets Free (Jesus), to begin the time of the great harvest and gather people from all nations who would represent the Great Spirit. The followers of Creator Sets Free, numbering about one hundred and twenty, were waiting and praying in the upstairs room where they were lodging. It had now been fifty days since the Passover festival.
